We will have 2 payment options for the June Recital Costume Fee. Please remember costume fees are non-refundable. See the website and/or ask the receptionist for prices.

- Installment Plan: Take advantage of paying costume fees over a 3-month period rather than one lump sum. The first installment will be due by October 7th; the second by November 7th; and the third by December 7th. If you choose not to pay by installment, then your total costume fee is due by December 7th. After that day there will be additional fees for shipping, etc..

Play Palace

All currently enrolled King's Dancers students will receive complimentary access to the indoor play space the day of their scheduled classes at no extra charge. For example: Jenny takes hip hop two days per week. She will be allowed to utilize the play space before or after her class on those days. Siblings would be required to pay for access to the play gym. Siblings of currently enrolled students would be given a special rate of \$5 per visit (unlimited time) or could opt for a special monthly individual child membership for \$10, or a family membership (multiple children) for \$15. Access to the play space would be limited to days of the enrolled sibling's classes. Please do not leave your child unattended in the Play Palace at any time. Play space is for ages 8 and under. **No Food Or Drink** allowed in Play Palace.

Tuition:

Please make every effort to pay tuition the first class of every month. There will be sign up sheet at the front desk if you would like to sign up to be sent an invoice

every month that allows you to pay online with a credit card through an email. Please Pay your first month at the desk and if you sign up for request to be emailed an invoice those will begin with October payments.

Things to bring:

Please have you or your child bring a water bottle. We do not have a water fountain in the studio. We do sell bottled water for \$1 that is cold. If you do not wish to purchase water please do not forget to come with a water bottle.
